Responsive Reading: Based on Psalm 50:1-5a &

Micah 6:6-8

Pastor: Who speaks to us?

Congregation: *The Mighty One, God the LORD, speaks and summons the earth from the rising of the sun to its setting.*

Pastor: From where does He speak?

Congregation: *Out of Zion, the perfection of beauty, God speaks out.*

Pastor: How does He speak?

Congregation: *When our God speaks; he does not keep silence; before him is a devouring fire, around him a mighty tempest.*

Pastor: To whom does He speak?

Congregation: *He calls to the heavens above and to the earth, that he may judge his people: He speaks to his faithful ones, the ones gathered.*

Pastor: And what does He say?

Congregation: *Our God says to us: "Don't come before me, your Lord on high, with burnt offerings or with calves a year old. Don't offer me thousands of rams or ten thousands of rivers of oil. Don't give me your firstborn or the fruit of my body. What I want from you, O people, is that which is good; I want you to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with me, your God!"*

1st Lesson – Isaiah 66:1-2, 22-23

This is what the LORD says: "Heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool. Where is the house you will build for me? Where will my resting place be? Has not my hand made all these things, and so they came into being?" declares the LORD. "These are the ones I look on with favor: those who are humble and contrite in spirit, and who tremble at my word. "As the new heavens and the new earth that I make will endure before me," declares the LORD, "so will your name and descendants endure. ..."

1st Lesson – (cont'd)

...From one New Moon to another and from one Sabbath to another, all mankind will come and bow down before me," says the LORD.

2nd Lesson – Hebrews 12:12-15a

Therefore lift your drooping hands and strengthen your weak knees, and make straight paths for your feet, so that what is lame may not be put out of joint but rather be healed. Strive for peace with everyone, and for the holiness without which no one will see the Lord. See to it that no one fails to obtain the grace of God.

Gospel – Luke 12:49-53

When he noticed how the guests picked the places of honor at the table, he told them this parable: "When someone invites you to a wedding feast, do not take the place of honor, for a person more distinguished than you may have been invited. If so, the host who invited both of you will come and say to you, 'Give this person your seat.' Then, humiliated, you will have to take the least important place. But when you are invited, take the lowest place, so that when your host comes, he will say to you, 'Friend, move up to a better place.' Then you will be honored in the presence of all the other guests. For all those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted. Then Jesus said to his host, "When you give a luncheon or dinner, do not invite your friends, your brothers or sisters, your relatives, or your rich neighbors; if you do, they may invite you back and so you will be repaid. But when you give a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind, and you will be blessed. Although they cannot repay you, you will be repaid at the resurrection of the righteous."

On the Last Day He will raise me and all the dead, and give eternal life to me and all believers in Christ. This is most certainly true.

Don't let me gloat over praise on one hand or be discouraged by criticism on the other.
