MEN: My cup overflows.

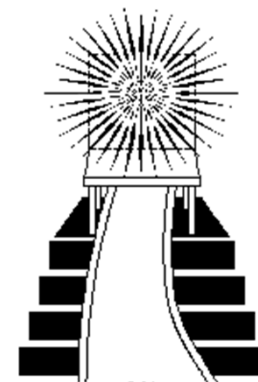
WOMEN: Goodness and mercy follow me all the days of my life.
